HISTORIC GROWTH AND IMPACT

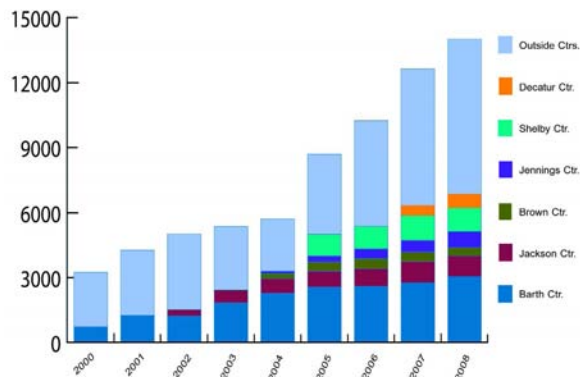
During the mid-1980's concerned citizens throughout the U. S. formed organizations to meet the needs of women facing crisis pregnancies. In 1983 Mother and Unborn Baby was established in Shelbyville. In November of 1985, the Abba Crisis Pregnancy Center was formed in Columbus. The intention of these organizations was to provide alternatives to abortion and support to women who felt frightened, confused or helpless because of an unplanned or crisis pregnancy. These ministries ultimately became what is now known as Pregnancy Care Centers of South Central Indiana (PCC-SCI). Since those early years the Pregnancy Care Center ministry has grown vastly in outreach.

Through the adoption of existing centers and birthing new ones, PCC-SCI now has centers in six counties: Bartholomew, Brown, Decatur, Jackson, Jennings and Shelby. These centers help women and men find help and hope in some of their most challenging days. Free pregnancy tests are available and those with positive tests are eligible for a free ultrasound scan. We also provide our clients material support that includes baby clothes and supplies, a car seat and a crib. Every woman or man who visits the center receives wise counsel so they can make informed choices concerning their circumstance.

In 1993 the *Choose To Wait* speakers bureau was established, utilizing staff and volunteers to instruct young people in sexual integrity through area schools. The interactive, media driven presentations are embraced among teachers and students alike. In 2005 a faith-based curriculum for teens and their parents, *Transformed*, was introduced for churches. Just this year *My Best For You*, a curriculum for upper elementary aged children and their parents was added to our arsenal of faith based sexual integrity programming. These two programs equip parents to pass on their values to the next generation.

Another element was added in 1996 as the ministry began to reach out to those facing the repercussions of their past choices. The first abortion recovery support group was held for those grieving past abortions. The 12 week *Forgiven and Set Free* Bible Study has mostly been held in Columbus in the past, but in 2008 a concerted effort was made to offer it in more communities. Though the number of individuals who participate in this portion of the ministry is much smaller than the others, the life-change that occurs in the participants and families that are affected by it is tremendous.

Since 2000 PCC-SCI has experienced amazing growth in our programming as well as the number of people touched by its work. The chart at right represents the growing impact of this ministry on the region as new elements have been added and more people have taken advantage of our offerings. The days to come will no doubt present new challenges and opportunities to the task of helping people live a lifestyle of sexual integrity. As we seek to meet both the challenges and opportunities, we trust God will provide all we need to continue affirming the value and dignity of every human life.

VOLUNTEERS

In addition to board members and staff, PCC-SCI has a team of more than 260 volunteers consisting of peer counselors, abstinence speakers, clerical and office volunteers, yard maintenance and house-keeping volunteers, abortion recovery volunteers, church ambassadors, and others who help with fund-raising, bulk mailing, and other periodic tasks.

All peer counselors and receptionists attend an in-depth training course using training materials developed by CARE NET. When in-class training is completed the volunteer receives additional training once in the center. *Choose to Wait, My Best for You, Transformed* and Abortion Recovery volunteers receive specific training for their area of service.

COMMUNITY EDUCATION

The *Choose to Wait* and *Wise Choices* Sexual Integrity programs for public education were presented to approximately 6,026 students in 2008 through more than 240 presentations in 35 schools. This was an increase of 920 students more than 2007.



Of the 6,026 students who observed the programs, 5,678 were anonymously surveyed. **Of those surveyed, 4,197 students indicated they intend to become or remain sexually abstinent until marriage. This is an average of 73.9%.** The following are schools/organizations in which *Choose to Wait* and *Wise Choices* were presented:

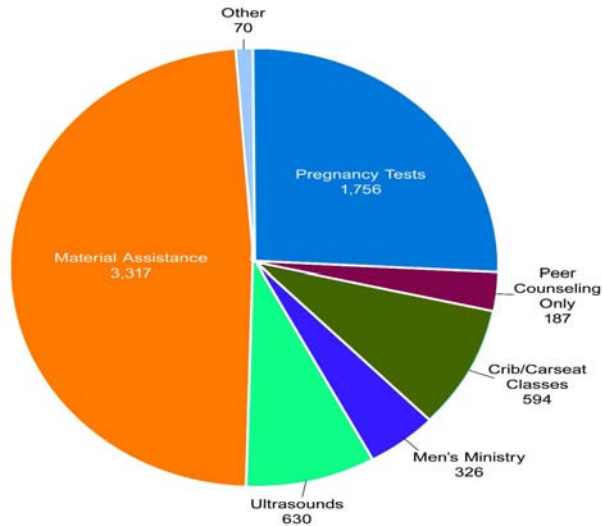

INTERVENTION

By providing clients with pregnancy tests, ultrasounds, options counseling and material assistance, our in-center services allow us the opportunity to share truth. Whether it is a teen girl who thinks she might be pregnant, a young father needing help with diapers for his baby or a woman facing an unplanned pregnancy looking for information on adoption, we are there meeting their physical needs while empowering them to make informed decisions regarding their situation with the love and compassion of Christ. All of our services are available at no cost to our clients. **In total, our six centers served 6,869 client visits in 2008.**

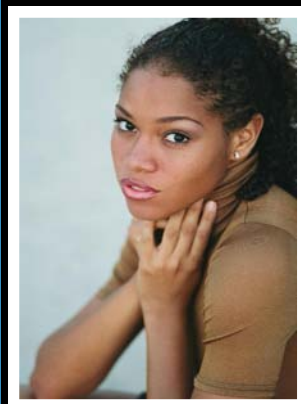
BREAKDOWN OF CLIENT VISITS



ANOTHER LIFE CHANGED

A young client, Joy*, came to the Center for a pregnancy test. Her mother, who was post-abortive, was encouraging Joy to abort. The peer counselor who saw Joy that day was post-abortive too. She shared her testimony with Joy and her mom and when they left that day, felt they were really listening to what she had to say. The day Joy came back to the Center for her ultrasound, she left indicating she was going to carry the baby and parent her child. Nine months later, Joy's beautiful baby was born. She came into the Center with her mom and best friend to pick up a layette. It was Joy's mother that was bragging and telling about what a precious little grand baby she had and what a proud grandmother she was.

FORGIVEN AND SET FREE

Our *Forgiven and Set Free* Abortion Recovery Bible Study and support group programs provide women who have experienced abortion, counsel and care within a confidential, small group setting. This interaction with others who have had similar experiences and in-depth study of the Scriptures allow women with wounded spirits to experience the hope, peace, forgiveness and love of their Heavenly Father. These studies are also available on an individual basis. In 2008, eight women went through the *Forgiven and Set Free* Bible Study and support group.



Excerpt from *Forgiven and Set Free* prayer letter:

"The *Forgiven and Set Free* Bible Study has finally come to a close. A season of healing and growing closer to the Lord has provided our ladies with peace and wholeness. As we discussed the healing that has taken place in their lives, the ladies expressed gratitude for this time in their lives and the amazing things God has accomplished in their hearts!

In the beginning, Hope* wanted forgiveness for her abortions. She has experienced that forgiveness now and desires to give other women hope that they too

can live in forgiveness of their sin of abortion. She has come to recognize and honor her unborn babies with love and dignity.

During the opening chapters, Hope described the state of her heart as bleeding with rejection, hurt, shame, guilt and abandonment. By the grace of God, she now feels accepted, forgiven, freed, victorious, alive, hopeful and ready to do whatever work God has for her to help reconcile other hurting women to Him. She feels her heart is in continual praise to the Lord for what He has done for her. She has also requested to be baptized as a result of truly understanding and accepting Jesus as her Lord and Savior!"

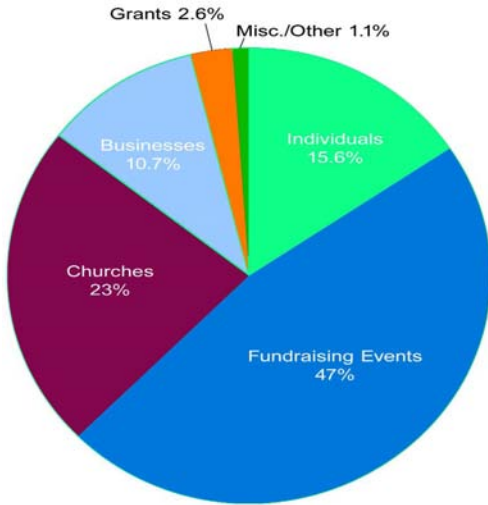

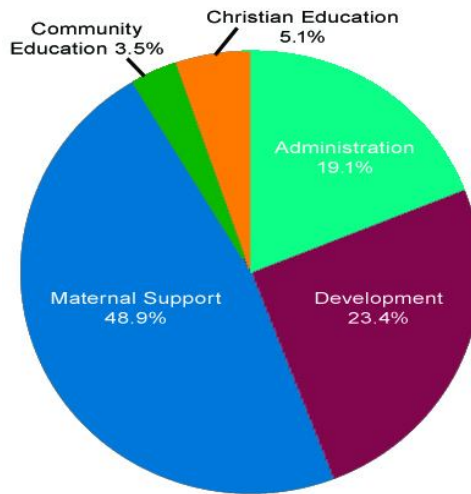
2008 FINANCES

Because the Pregnancy Care Centers of South Central Indiana (PCC-SCI) is a Christian ministry that cherishes the privilege of praying and appropriately sharing the Gospel with anyone coming to us for help, it does not accept any state or federal government funding. All funding is obtained through fundraising activities directed by the PCC-SCI board of directors and free-will gifts from local churches, individuals, private organizations, foundations and businesses. All contributions are tax deductible as PCC-SCI is a non-profit, 501 (c)(3), tax exempt corporation. PCC-SCI does not charge for any of its services.
